Dear Applicant for Homeownership:

Thank you for your interest in the <u>Homeownership Program of Better Community Housing of Trenton, Inc.</u> (BCHT). We expect to have 5 houses available on Tyrell Avenue over the next several years, with one available in 2021 and four in 2022-23. To qualify you must meet our **eligibility criteria (see next page)** and fulfill our sweat equity, community service, and class requirements.

BCHT wants you to understand the financial and maintenance challenges of obtaining homeownership. Our housing program is designed to help you overcome some of these challenges. BCHT cannot guarantee homeownership for you. However, if you qualify according to all of the eligibility requirements and your application is approved, BCHT's process can help you through the process of obtaining a house, maintaining the property, and becoming a successful homeowner.

Please be advised that the cost of finance, labor, and materials requires BCHT to apply for funds and grants to supplement the amount the homeowner pays for a home. To help us keep the cost of finance and homeownership at a level you can pay for and maintain according to your income, BCHT must request your work efforts of participation and involvement in sweat equity.

BCHT's sweat equity process requires 50 volunteer hours while waiting for a house, then 5-7 hours or 1 day of work each month for the life of your mortgage or installment sale agreement. The work can include the following: work on housing construction, work at the BCHT office, participate in training classes, attend community meetings (required), work on committees, community projects, and other BCHT work.

If you satisfy all of the criteria on the next page, please fill out our application and make an appointment to bring it in. If your application is approved, you can begin BCHT's process to become a homeowner.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - HOMEOWNERSHIP PROGRAM**

- 1) The nature of Better Community Housing of Trenton, Incorporated (BCHT) is to have an opportunity to build families and a community. For this reason, applications are accepted from families with at least 3 persons in the family.
- 2) You may not already own a house or property.
- 3) You may not already have a house or property registered in a minor child's name that is under your custody or legal guardianship.
- 4) You may not have "large" outstanding debts for loans, credit cards, installment payments, layaways, etc. And your regular monthly bills (rent, PSE&G, heating-oil, telephone, insurances, car note, tuition, cable, credit cards and other financing bills) cannot be greater than 90% of your monthly income. This would make it too difficult for you to financially maintain the property, pay taxes, water/sewer, and homeowner's insurance bills.
- 5) With your application, you must submit <u>two-years</u> of reliable documentation of current bill payments (rent, PSE&G, telephone) in your name.
- 6) BCHT abides by HUD Regional Income Limits for the Trenton NJ MSA, so you must meet the Very-Low-Income standards for your family size for the current year. The 2020 income limits for various household sizes are shown below. Complete the BCHT Application for Housing and **submit proof of income** for all adults age 18 years of age or older who will reside in the house.

- 7) Note: If BCHT established a contractual relationship on the home you will be purchasing with, for example, the City, State, and or Federal government, you are subject to qualifications, eligibility, and compliance with said requirements and procedures.
- 8) BCHT's sweat equity process requires 100 volunteer hours before getting a house and 8 hours or 1 day of work each month for the duration of the mortgage or installment sale agreement. Sweat equity may include: work on houses, work at the BCHT office, participating in training classes, attending community meetings, working on committees, community projects, and other BCHT work.

Please understand that these criteria are the standards that will ultimately help us help you become a successful homeowner.

Most of our homes have 3 bedrooms, 1½ baths, and a laundry hookup. You should be prepared to pay close to \$600 a month to cover mortgage/rent, taxes, water/sewer, and homeowners' insurance, plus \$200 or more for gas and electric.

To help you figure out whether your income will qualify as noted in #4 and #6 above, while still being able to pay your bills, please fill out the **Monthly Income and Expense Record** on the following page. Bring this form with you when you submit your application, and we will help you create a budget to help you cover the expenses of maintaining a house and paying taxes, water/sewer, and homeowner's insurance bills.
